- Tanya Olesiak at Sweat Tea Vinyl will provide the vinyl lettering on our prizes in exchange for a sponsor banner.
- Kim will order blue ribbons.

- Need to add sponsors to show bill and order new banners.
- Sponsor money and membership forms turned in to secretary. Still waiting on a few sponsors.
